A reminder on how to book in for an interview time by following the steps below.

#### **ON-LINE BOOKING SYSTEM**

- STEP 1 Go to www.schoolinterviews.co.nz
- **STEP 2** Enter in the following code where it says "Parents School Event Code" **mprrb**
- **STEP 3** Type in your email address (this is so a confirmation of your interview booking can be sent back to you) Type in your name, then your child's name (if you have more than one child at school use the drop down box so more 'Student's Name' lines appear. Press **GO**
- **STEP 4** Choose your child's teacher from the drop down list. Press **GO**
- STEP 5 Choose the times you would like to see each teacher then press GO. The time you have booked for each student will appear. Once you have finished press 'Finish' then an email will be sent to confirm your parent interview booking.

#### **Road Crossings**

Due to previous road law changes, we are changing the way we manage the road patrol crossing (*zebra crossing*) on Grants Road. In the afternoon the crossing will <u>no longer be managed by a road patrol</u>. Instead, this is changing to the students using it as a Zebra crossing. Training for the students will be provided in conjunction with the school and the *Police School Community* officer which will take place in Week 3. In the interim Teachers will *continue to supervise the students t*o ensure they become active in their decision making around road safety. More information will be provided as the training progresses.

#### Swim Safe Swimming Lessons Year 5 - 8

Kereta and Acacia children (plus the Year 5's from Waipopo) will be participating in Swim Safe lessons at CBay in Week 4 and 5 this term – 22 February to 5 March.
